Re:	2024 Capital Projects and Capital Replacement Budget Amendment

Background:

Capital Replacement

Vehicle Replacement - Hiring a fleet manager at the beginning of this year has come with a new approach to vehicle replacement. Several trucks were identified for replacement based on the fleet manager's recommendation which had not been included in the budget. The amended budget reflects these additional costs.

Website Redesign – originally included in the operating budget as a consultant expense. During the audit process it was recommended that this be classified as a digital asset and included in the capital replacement schedule to more accurately reflect the expense.

Fieldhouse entrance renovation – A portion of this line item was spent on the design and construction documents. The bulk of it was reserved for construction, but the request for proposals did not attract any bidders. This will be added to the project list for 2025.

Trail projects - The restoration and improvement of the Wasatch soft surface trail was a late addition so was not included in the original proposed budget. Asphalt replacement expenses were overlooked in the original budget but is still a necessary project for the year.

Capital Projects

Silver Creek Village soft surface trail - added in response to the various planning processes completed after the adoption of the 2024 budget. Silver Creek Village is a focus area for many future capital projects and the addition of the trail with existing impact fee funds was a strategic step forward for this site.

Additional Design/Engineering Costs – after completion of the Strategic Action Plan and hiring of new staff on the project team, the District's approach to projects is being refined. Staff



would like to allocate some funding for design and engineering for projects that are scheduled for future completion. As we begin several large capital projects, this will give the District more lead time to procure, permit, and complete projects.
